

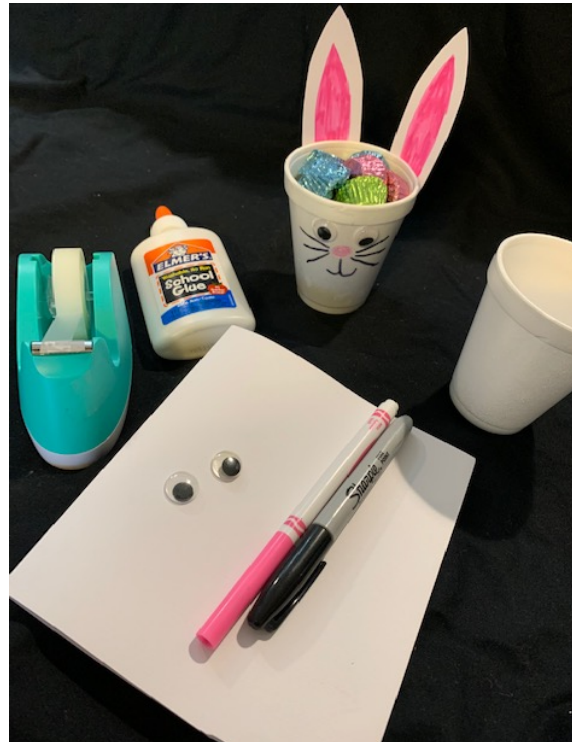
Craft Corner

Bunny Treat Cup!



Materials Needed:

- Foam cup,
- white cardstock (or white paper),
- 2 googly eyes (or black marker to draw eyes)
- glue,
- tape,
- black and pink markers (or other colors you have on hand)

Directions:

- Fold White paper in half. Draw a rabbit ear and make as pointy as you like. Keeping paper folded, cut out the ears. You should have two when done.
- Use a pink marker to fill in the ears. Be sure to leave some white around the edges of the ears.
- Tape both ears to the outside of the back of the cup. Use plenty of tape to make it sturdy.
- Glue googly eyes to the top of the cup, or draw the eyes using a black marker.
- Use a pink marker to create a circle for the nose and color it in.
- Use a black marker to draw mouth and whiskers. Fill your super cute cup with tasty treats!
