

## Craft Corner

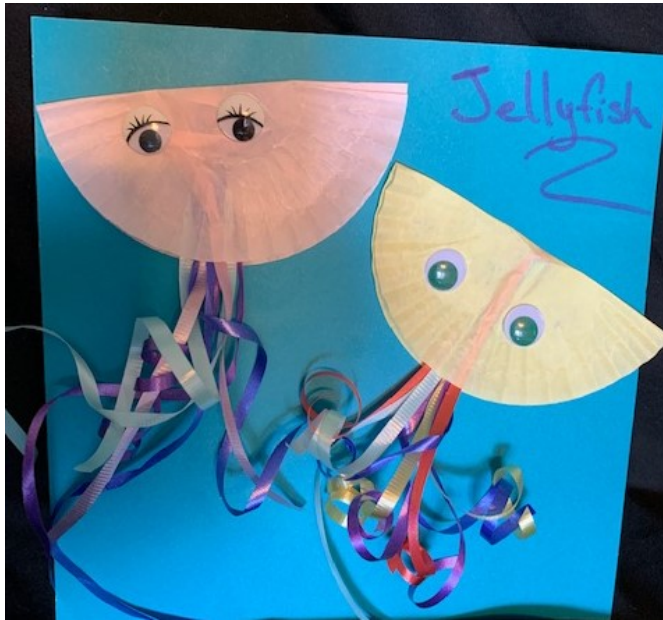

### Jellyfish



### Materials Needed:

- 2 cupcake liners,
- curling ribbon,
- googly eyes or markers,
- blue construction paper,
- glue,
- tape

### Directions:

Fold cupcake liners in half and only glue one side to blue paper. (If you do not have blue construction paper, have child color a white sheet of paper with a blue marker or crayon creating an ocean background). The fold should be at the top making liner look like an upside-down fan.

Cut 4 strips of curling ribbon approximately 12 inches long. I used 4 different colors. (If you do not have curling ribbon you can use yarn or even streamers!)

Fold the ribbon in half making a loop. Tape the loop of ribbon to the inside of the cupcake liner. You should now have 8 tentacles.

Using glue stick place glue on the top of the liner and fold over sealing the ribbon. Press down firmly.

Glue on googly eyes or draw in with a marker. If you like you can curl the ribbon using scissors.
