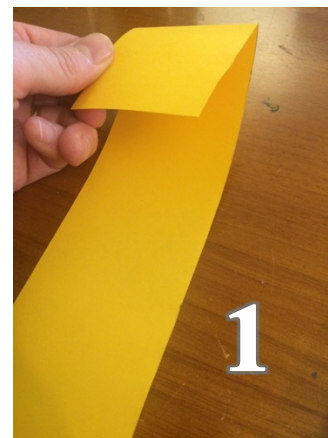
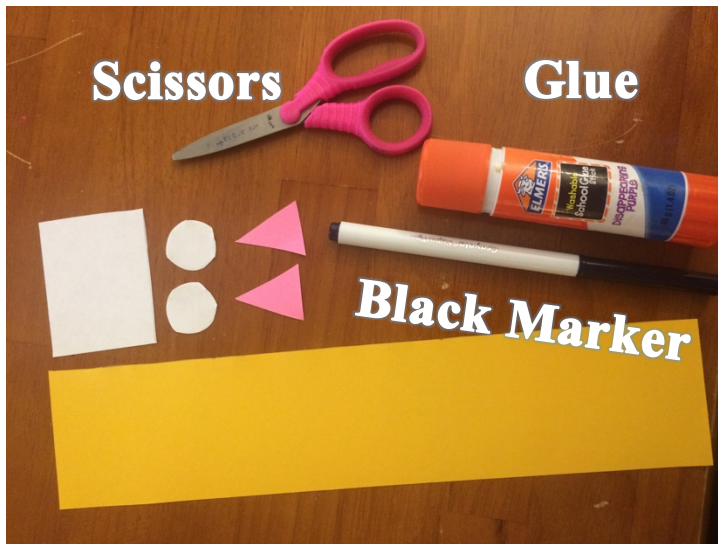


Monster Fold-Over Bookmarks

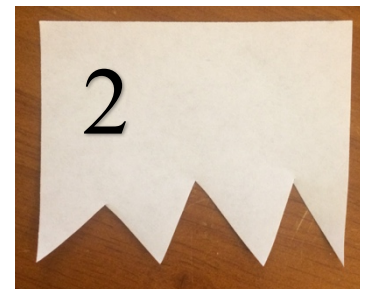
Supplies:

- 1 strip of colored paper (approximately 2 ¼ inches wide by 10 inches long)
- 1 strip of white paper (approximately 2 ¼ inches wide by 2 inches long)
- 2 small circles cut out of the white paper. (These will be your monster's eyes. You can just use one larger circle if you want your monster to have only one eye.)
- 2 small triangles made from a different color of paper.



Directions:

1. Approximately 2 inches from the top, fold down the colored paper strip. (See picture.)
2. Cut jagged “teeth” into the longer side of the white strip of paper. (See picture.)
3. Glue teeth paper to folded part of colored paper so the “teeth” show.
4. Use the black marker to add circles to the eyes.
5. Glue eyes to the monster's face.
6. Glue triangles to back of the monster's head so its horns stick up.
7. Use marker to add extras such as angry eye brows.
8. Wait for glue to dry before using monster bookmark to keep your place in your book.
