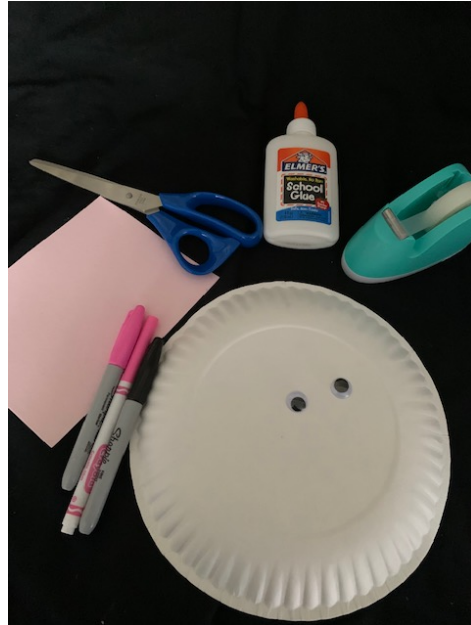
### Recommended books:

### Paper Plate Pig



**Materials Needed:** Paper plate, pink and black markers or crayons, light pink paper, googly eyes, glue, tape, scissors

### Instructions:

- Color entire back of plate with pink markers or crayons.
- Fold pink paper in half. Cut out triangles for ears. Should have two if paper is folded. If you do not have pink paper, use plain white and color with pink marker. Try to color a bit lighter than the face.
- Unfold remaining paper and cut out an oval shape for the snout.
- Glue ears to back of plate so that they stick up in front.
- Draw two black circles on the snout and glue to plate along with eyes. If you don't have googly eyes, draw them like the example! Or you can cut out two circles for the eyes and use as a mask!
