Requirements

Must live within the Library service district, a 53-square-mile area in northwestern Warren County that encompasses the cities of Franklin and Carlisle, and all of Franklin Township, the city of Springboro and the area of Clearcreek Township that lies west of Bunnel Hill Road.

Responsibilities

- Prepare for and attend regular board meetings.
- Assist in the review and approval of the annual budget and monthly expenditures.
- Participate in the development and approval of library policies.
- Support the needs of the Library Director.
- Study the needs and interests of the community.
- Act as an advocate for the library.
- Become familiar with principals and issues relation to intellectual freedom.
- Assist in the formulation and adoption of a long-range plan for the library.

Commitment

- Attend board meetings (every 3rd Thursday of the month).
- Attend committee meetings (as needed).
- Term is 7 years. Begins January 1, 2022.
